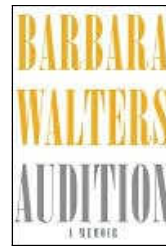
We are looking forward to planning next year's "Touch A Truck" program with an even greater number of interesting vehicles and other activities.



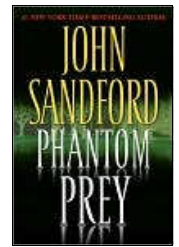
