ARTISTIC HELP AT THE LIBRARY

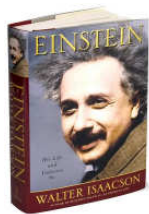


We would like to thank Miranda Hale for her help decorating the library windows with the "Get A Clue @ Your Library" theme.
