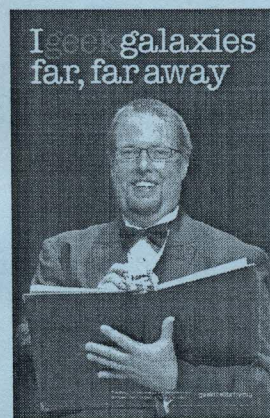
ter way to spend that month?
