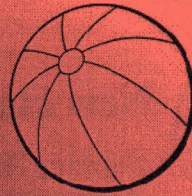

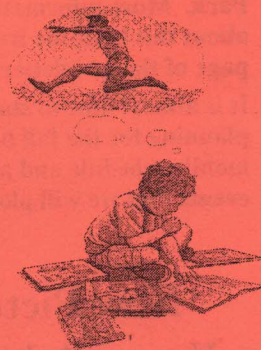
They finally got the landscaping done in
