2016 was a really exciting year for the library and 2017 promises to be even more exciting. We are hoping to have a few more events in the library and to have as much fun if not more for summer reading!

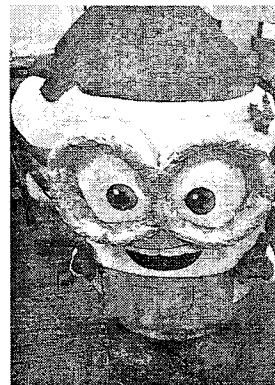
The permanent bookdrop is in place in

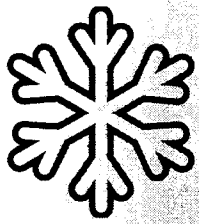

## New Happenings in Kenmare

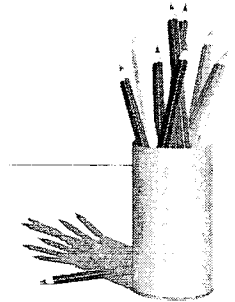
There is a lot happening in Kenmare right now! Bree is planning a coloring contest! There is more information about that on page 4.

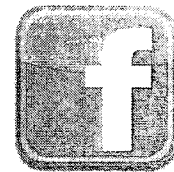
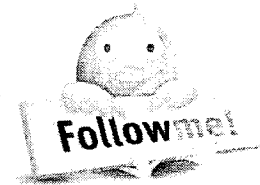
It is finally not snowing today even though it is super chilly. Days like this make me long for summer, but I do love winter as well.
