

Attention Ward County Voters: On election day, polls open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m. The polling locations are listed below along with a map of the polling locations and legislative districts. Early voting is the Monday through Friday the week prior to election day between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., in Rooms 106 and 108 of the County Administration Building, 225 SE 3rd St, Minot.





You **must** have a North Dakota ID with name, date of birth and ND residential address on it. Four forms of acceptable identification are a Driver's License, Non-Driver's ID, Tribal Government issued ID or a Long Term Care Certificate issued by a ND facility. You may bring supplemental proof of address including utility bills, bank statements, PO Box change of address, etc., if your ID address is incorrect.

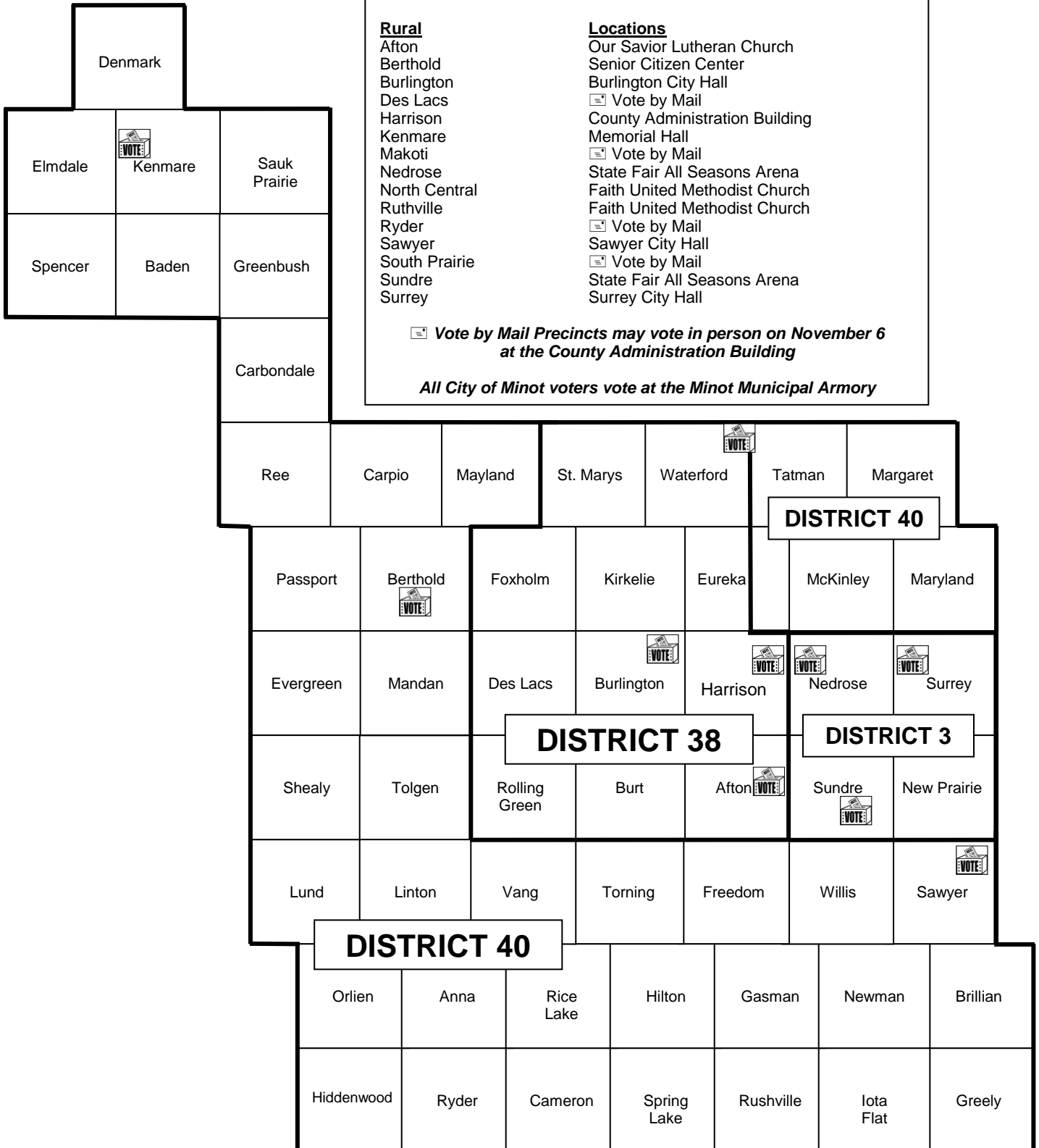
